Cllr Rees declared interest in the community grant application received from the church in Berryfields.

23.3 Open forum (under adjournment):

A member of the public brought to light that some of the walkways in Berryfields are not sufficient; he concluded that due to long drives and narrow pavements, often pedestrians are forced to walk down a particular (unbusy) road, especially when some members of the public park on the roadside - the gentleman believes more work can be done to prevent this. This comment was noted by Councillors.

Another member of the public brought several points to light. These included:

- Parking blocking driveways
- High traffic on main roads possibly due to parked cars (particularly in mornings and afternoons)
- Speeding around play areas.
- Lack of awareness / exposure of the ongoings of the parish council

All the above points were noted by councillors, and some will be further deliberated.

Cllrs discuss possible ways of further community awareness of events. This matter is to be further deliberated.

The parish council attended a grant funding presentation and were awarded £6000 pound grant by the Thames Valley community fund towards the purchase of CCTV in a park.
