Sharing my Passion

My name is Melanie and I'm writing to share my passion with my fellow Berryfielders. My family and I moved here in July of this year- right at the beginning of the Summer holidays. This meant that my two daughters and I spent the next 6 weeks exploring Berryfields and all of the surrounding villages in the sunshine.

The reason I mention my daughters (aged 2 and 6 years old) is because my passion was born with them. I'm a Pilates and yoga teacher as well as an Ayurveda health coach, and the reason why I am all of these things is because I was told that having babies would be extremely unlikely for me. I had polycystic ovaries which is an extremely common condition in the UK. This condition can make periods irregular due to irregular ovulation or no ovulation at all. It can also lead to hair loss or excessive hair growth, skin conditions such as acne and weight gain.



Now, I wasn't adamant that I was going to have children, but I was adamant I was going to do something about having polycystic ovaries! It was then that I became more interested in yoga (I had practised for about fifteen years by that point) and also in herbs and how they can be used medicinally. I made it my mission to learn which asanas (yoga poses) were most beneficial for women, and began to practice them every day. I also enrolled in an Ayurveda foundation course. This was in 2018, when I unexpectedly became pregnant with my first daughter. My efforts had worked!

Whilst she was a baby I decided to build on my knowledge and study a diploma in Ayurveda. Ayurveda – as many people with an Indian background will know – is a traditional system of medicine which has been practised for around 6000 years or more. It focuses on the balance between the body, mind, spirit and environment to achieve health and prevent disease. It literally means 'the science of life' in Sanskrit.

When my daughter was a little older, I became qualified to teach yoga, and just as I was about to start teaching publicly, I became pregnant again with my second daughter in 2022. I had such terrible pregnancy nausea and pelvic girdle pain that I couldn't do much physically, but I was elated anyhow!

The hip pain made me determined to build strength after my second daughter was born and so I did, qualifying as a Pilates teacher. I now teach a mix of Pilates, yoga and other calisthenics to women who are post-partum, whether that's 4 months or 40 years post-partum! I also teach women exercises which can aid fertility on the way that I managed for myself. I specialise in re-building and strengthening the core, hip girdle and pelvis, as well as regulating menstrual cycles and the moods that go with them. I have a special interest in peri-menopause and the menopause, and love talking about and researching everything women's health!

It's funny as I was always quite a tom-boy and worked in male dominated environments in my old life, but nowadays my passion is all things women!

I wanted to share that with my fellow Berryfielders, particularly as environment plays such a big part in our well-being. We are so lucky to be surrounded by so much greenery, fields with sheep, trees and wild flowers. Life can get a bit much sometimes, but here in Berryfields we have something special – a welcoming community and fresh, clean air to breathe!

Anti-Bullying Week

During anti-Bullying week the Year 7 students were lucky enough to be visited by one of our former students, Joshua Ainger-Boyt. Josh spoke to the students about his time at AVA and how he demonstrated our core values of respect, resilience, and aspiration – both in his studies and through his passion for martial arts. While studying at AVA, Josh competed in kickboxing tournaments across the world and has achieved incredible success in the sport. Most recently, he took 1st place at the Arnold Championships UK.

Josh is now training to represent Team GB in the 2028 Olympics. He's said he will come back when he takes home Gold to talk to the students who will then be in year 10. It was a pleasure to welcome Josh back and for our students to hear his inspiring story.



Parliament Week

UK Parliament Week is an annual, nationwide celebration that engages people with the work of the UK Parliament and democracy. It has been designed to encourage schools to explore what Parliament does and how they can get involved.

What did we do?

Student Parliament took part in their first AVA debate, focusing on the motion:

"The House believes mobile phones should be allowed in school for learning." The students' showed aspiration, preparation, and resilience throughout the debate. Participants ranged from Year 7 to Year 12, with Emily J leading the proposing team and Megan W heading the opposition. Every student demonstrated thorough research and delivered their speeches with confidence and respect. Results from the debate were in favour of the proposition.

Student Parliament also took part in a Q&A with the local Parish Council who kindly came in to talk about their role within the community. During tutor time and Personal Development lessons students looked at the house system linking it to our core values. Voting opens for the house system today, linking nicely to the theme of democracy.

Harvest

In October our Student Parliament took on the important task of sorting the incredible Harvest donations we received for Aylesbury Vineyard Storehouse. Thanks to a wonderful joint effort between our primary and secondary students, we were able to donate just under 1000 items to the foodbank. Once everything was bagged and boxed, several members of Student Parliament helped deliver the donations to the Vineyard.

Aylesbury Vineyard has asked us to pass on their heartfelt gratitude for our generous Harvest contribution. They shared how much our donation will help bless the local community by supporting families and individuals in need. They also mentioned how lovely it was to see our students assisting with the delivery and proudly told us that, after weighing everything, our school's donation was the largest Harvest collection they've received from any school this year!



Community Project

In November, AVA Prefects launched their annual Community Project in collaboration with our feeder schools – AVA Primary, Green Ridge Academy Primary, and Buckingham Park Primary. During the session, students explored the future they envision and shared ideas about how they would like their local community to look. The discussion was full of creativity and bright ideas.

Students are now working on the next stage of the project: delivering an assembly in their own schools. Our ultimate goal is to create a 'Pledge Wall' across Berryfields, where everyone can commit to continuing to make our community a respectful and welcoming place for all.
